Caroline Lease is a microbiologist by day and an animal rescuer by night.

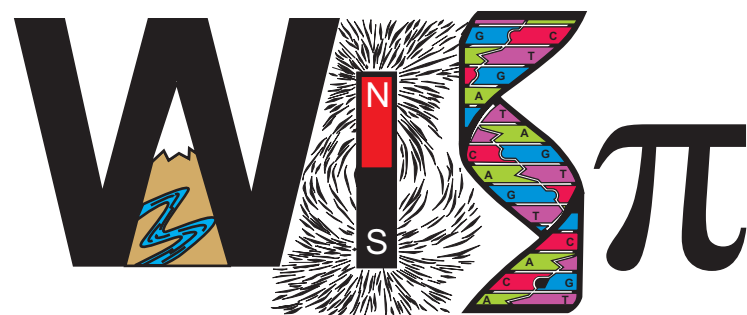
