

Participation Grade

The final grade calculation in CSC 136 includes a 2% participation grade. This grade is based on a 28 point scale. Those 28 points are accumulated on a per week basis as follows:

1. Each student will get one point if he or she attends class and demonstrates some participation. (13 points; excludes week 1 and finals week)
2. By noon on Monday each week a running average will be displayed in D2L. Any student whose running average is 75% or higher will automatically receive a participation point. The average you will view is the one listed under “Final Calculated Grade”. Students whose average is below 75% may earn the participation point by attending a supplemental instructor or tutor session (see session rules below). (13 points; excludes week 1 and finals week)
3. Each student that turns in all assignments on time will get an extra 2 points at the end of the semester. (2 points)

NOTE: Any student may attend a supplemental or tutoring session for help any time. It is only required to earn participation points by those whose average is too low.
