Programming Assignments

Requirements

- 1. If there is evidence of copying, all students involved will receive a 0 for that assignment.
- 2. If the program does not compile (syntax errors), the student will receive a 0 for that assignment.
- 3. The program must be turned in on the due date/time or the program will be considered late. There will be a 10% deduction for each <u>calendar</u> day the program is late.

All programming assignments must follow the department documentation standard, which is available on the CS&IT Department web site (https://www.kutztown.edu/csit). In addition to the information identified in that document for the ID block, you must also include the following information:

- Language used and version
- Compilation command (how to compile program)
- Execution command (how to execute the program)

You should also follow good programming practices, which include inline comments (comments throughout your code), structured format (include blank lines, indent, etc.), appropriate keywords, appropriate use of functions, etc.
