Teamwork

The project in this course will be a team project. While each team member will have a clearly defined role, the team is expected to work collaboratively to complete the project. The team leader is expected to ensure all team members are working effectively and that the team will meet the project deadline successfully.

Teamwork requires collaboration, cooperation and building rapport among team members. Some skills that will be required of each team to successfully complete this project are:

- Communication clear and efficient communication will be required; sharing relevant information and ideas; listen to all ideas from all team members
- Responsibility each team member must clearly understand the work assigned to them; each team member must meet deadlines
- Honesty team members must be open and honest with each other and work through disagreements; each team member must be honest about not being able to complete a task or meet a deadline
- Respect team members must be respectful of the other team members; all ideas are worthwhile
