Quality and quantity of research completed and/or ongoing. 3. Personal characteristics and work habits likely to lead to success in graduate school. 4. Quality point average in psychology and overall.
Senior Comps	Highest 3 scores on the comps.
Psi Chi Model Student	Psi Chi member who best exemplifies Psi Chi's twin ideals of scholarship and service.
Scientist/Practitioner	Excellence in both research and fieldwork.
Field Experience	Excellence in field and internship experience.
Jaymie Creitz Scholarship	Female student, entered KU through Extended Learning, 21 credits or more, commitment to animal welfare and/or MADD/SADD.
Keller-Sharp Research Fund	Quality of research proposal.
Academic Achievement	Highest GPA
Student Leadership	Leadership in department activities and organizations (Psych Club, Psi Chi) and leadership in other on- or off-campus organizations.
Research	Excellence in research.
