# Transfer to Rare Books

#### Determining if a book is a Rare Book

The Archivist will determine if a volume is to be considered a RARE BOOK. Any questionable items delivered to Technical Services need to be brought to the attention of the Archivist before proceeding with any repairs.

## Physical Processing of Rare book items

In general Rare Books are not physically altered, because physical processing may decrease its value. This means no stamping, no ink, and no glue. The only exceptions are noted below.

Tattle-tape is applied to all Rare Book items.

### Adding a call number


#### If a book already has a Rohrbach Library call number:

Often a book is identified as a Rare Book after it has already been assigned to one of our other collections. In these cases the book's value has already been compromised by physical processing. Adding a new call label and/or new barcode over top of the old label is permissible, because it will in no way further decrease the value of the item.

#### If a book does not have a Rohrbach Library call number:

Adhere the barcode and pocket label (long label) to the top of a

3" x11" white card stock. (See example below.) Place the card stock inside of the book.
