AUDIO COMPACT DISCS

May 1993 (Revised: December 4, 1994) (Revised: 29 August 2001) (Updated: 30 November, 2001)

Audio compact discs which accompany a title require the inclusion of a subfield **e** in the 300 field and are formatted as follows:

The 949 field would be formatted as follows:

Print the call number on the disc with a fine-tip permanent marker. Then attach the special compact disc security strips following manufacturer's specifications.

Discs accompanying a book may require the creation of a pocket in the back of the book to house the disc[s]. Generate a label for the disc, utilizing only the pocket label[s] to be attached to the disc's pocket.

To alert Circulation of any accompanying disc, attach notes to the front cover of a title. The note is printed on brightly colored paper and indicates the need to avoid contact with the electronic sensors. A note is also attached alerting Circulation personnel to use only the special media sensitizer/desensitizer.
